



MEDICAL MARIHUANA FACILITY APPLICATION PERMITTING UPDATE

The City of Douglas will begin distributing Medical Marihuana Facility Applications on August 27, 2018 and begin accepting them on August 30, 2018.

UPDATE: Interested persons may create a line at ***the rear entrance (NORTH SIDE)*** of City Hall in anticipation of the date and time applications will first be accepted. A representative of the applicant must be physically present at all times in order to maintain a spot in line. Applicants are permitted to stand or to sit in portable folding chairs while in line but no tents, beds, or shelter of any kind will be permitted in the line. Applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis as determined by the applicant's place in line.

If severe weather becomes a threat, individuals in line will be given a ticket that corresponds with the applicant's number in line. These individuals will then be able to seek shelter and return when the weather clears. This exception will take effect when a severe weather warning is announced by the WOOD TV8 Weather App for the Douglas area. Physical presence by applicants must begin again when the warning expires.
